

As the summer is fast approaching, we wanted to share some important information regarding our Health Center and some of its policies.

At one time or another, your camper is likely to visit the Health Center. In order to treat your child we must have all medical forms and a copy of your insurance card submitted to your MYCAW account no later than June 10th.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY MEDICAL FORMS TO THE BUS

A Health Center Staff Member for any of the following reasons will call you:

- If your camper spends the night in the Health Center for any reason
- If your camper requires a trip to the hospital for any reason
- If a throat culture is taken and results are positive
- If x-rays are taken for any reason
- For any severe illness or injury
- If your child is put on any antibiotic
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If your child requires daily medication (PILL FORM ONLY), you MUST sign up with CAMP MEDS.

You need Camp Meds for **DAILY MEDICATION ONLY**. It does not apply for epi pens, inhalers, vitamins, liquid medications, growth hormones and creams. Bring these items in a clearly labeled Ziploc bag with your campers name and division to the bus depot and there will be a CAW staff member stationed at the lead van and they will collect any medication coming up to camp with your child. These collected medications are not part of the Camp Meds Program.

Please see the document that is on your MYCAW account, which has the complete list of Over The Counter Medications that we stock and have readily available for your camper. Please do not send any of the listed medications up to camp, as we will have plenty all summer long.

OUR GOAL IS TO BE LICE FREE

We strongly recommend you to have your camper checked for lice before they depart for camp. The spread of lice happens so easily and quickly, we need your help to ensure we are off to a lice free start of summer.

An authorized lice treatment company will screen all campers and staff three times during the summer:

- First day of camp – as campers arrive before entering their bunk
- After visiting day
- Just before camp ends and they head back home (lice free of course¹¹)

If your camper is found to have lice during the initial screening upon arrival to camp, we reserve the right to send the camper home for treatment. In these cases and upon returning to camp, we will require a written statement from an authorized lice treatment program verifying that the camper is lice free.

If your camper arrives to camp with lice and we treat the infestation, you are responsible to pay the fee of \$500. Please have your campers head checked right before camp begins. It is no fun to start the summer with lice! The Authorized Lice Company establishes treatment fees.

If your child has had lice within a few weeks of the start of camp, ***YOU MUST ADVISE THE CAMP OFFICE.***

Please send your camper with a clearly labeled brush. Our staff will make every effort to prevent campers from sharing brushes.

If at anytime during the summer your camper is screened positive for lice, we will contact you and begin treatment. Our treatment is 100% organic and safe. We do not utilize any type of prescription medication for the treatment of lice.

Pre –screening, checking your camper for lice and treating it before camp will only ensure a terrific start to the fun summer your camper has ahead of them.
